

Squash NZ Selection Criteria
2018 FISU World University Squash Championship
6-12 September 2018 Birmingham, UK.

Recommended Tournament

- 2018 Eye Rackets New Zealand Senior Nationals - Individual Championships 15th-17th June, Henderson, Auckland.

Selection will be based on:

- Tournament results from the past 12 months
- Eligible players performance in recommended tournament
- National Ranking Lists (Junior and Senior)
- Squash NZ Grading list
- Aged between 17 and 25 years old
- Past performances and progress for the year are taken into account

Selection

Up to 3 males for the individual event and team event; and up to 2 female players to participate in the individual event and team event.

The Squash NZ High Performance Manager and Senior Selectors will select the team.

Eligibility

Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country.

Former students of the institutions mentioned above who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.

Funding

These Championships will be entirely self-funded. Squash NZ will endorse funding applications to the selected players' universities. Application submissions are the responsibility of each player. An exact amount will be advised on selection.

WUC costs typically include:

1. 20 euro one off FISU Registration Fee
2. 70 Euro per person per day FISU Participation Fee (this includes accommodation in athlete's village/hall, food, transport)
3. Flights – NZ to Birmingham, UK.
4. Insurances – travel insurance
