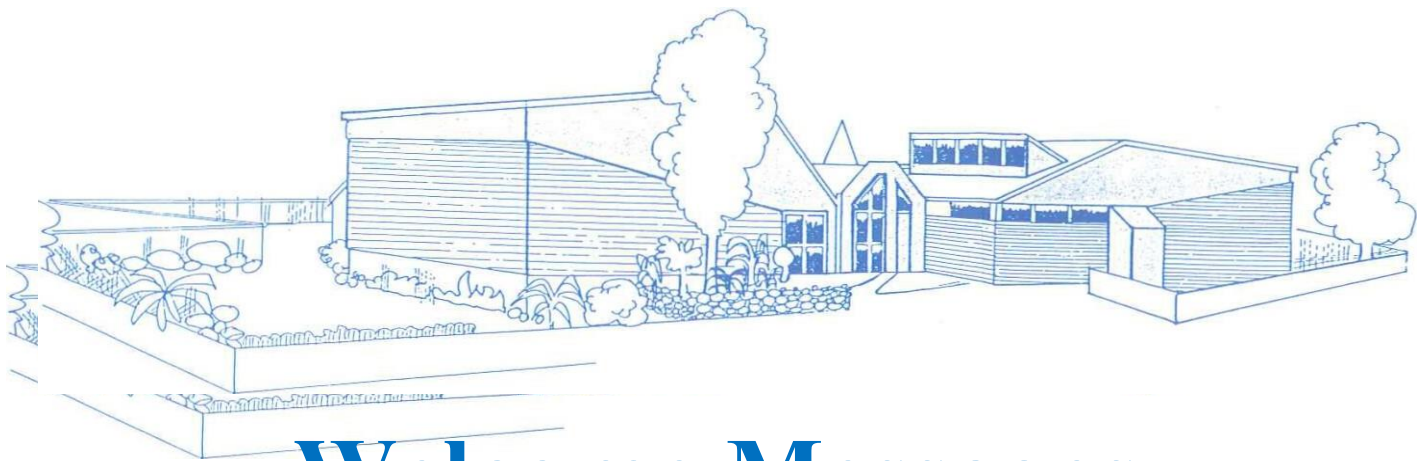

Welcome Messages

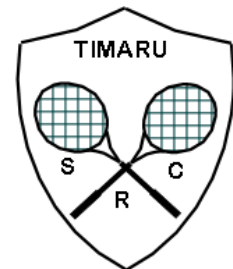
I would like to take this opportunity to welcome all players, coaches and supporters to the Timaru Squash Rackets Club.

All players must be available to mark and referee immediately after their game. You will be asked to referee the court beside that which you have just come off. Please do not use cell phones while refereeing.

As per squash rules, any player not on court within 10 minutes of their due start time will be liable to default.

Single dot yellow unless both players agree on alternative ball.

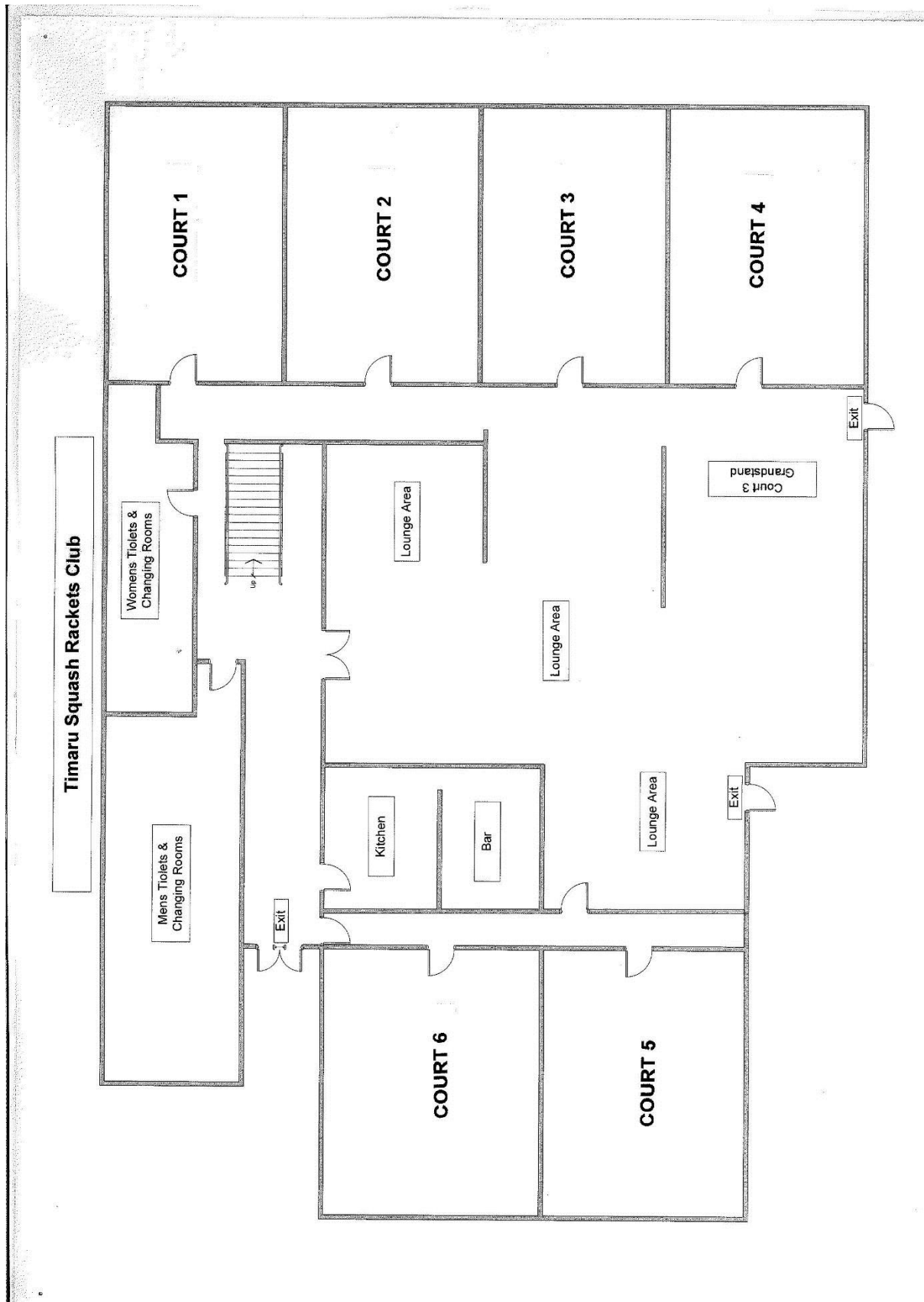

In Case Of Fire

1. Raise the Alarm by setting off the fire alarm on the lounge wall between the bar & kitchen
(leave it going!)
2. Phone the Fire Service on 111 saying:
 - You want the Fire Service

When connected say:

 - There is a FIRE
 - At the TIMARU SQUASH CLUB
 - North-West end of BRUNSWICK STREET, TIMARU
3. Check for a COMMITTEE MEMBER to act as WARDEN. If no one is available, don the Red armband and complete the WARDEN DUTIES yourself
4. Leave the lights on and smoke doors shut.
5. Ensure people are evacuating. Have them assemble on the Brunswick Street footpath (the designated assembly point!)
6. Check toilets, showers, all Courts 1 – 6 and the viewing gallery above 1,2 & 3.
7. Do not yourself, nor allow other people to return to the building until given the ALL CLEAR by the Fire Brigade
8. Report to the Fire Brigade on their arrival.
