Player Eligibility

Players must be registered with Squash New Zealand and a full financial member of an affiliated squash club.

Players must meet eligibility to represent New Zealand through either being born in New Zealand, or have became a naturalized citizen of, or have resided in New Zealand for at least three (3) years immediately preceding the Championships.

All players must have a valid WSF Squash Player Identification Number (SPIN) obtainable from WSF. N.B. This can be obtained after selection.

Player Selection Criteria

Squash New Zealand will select 5 Male and 5 Female players to represent New Zealand at the 2017 Oceania Closed Championships.

The SNZ Senior Selectors will determine the athletes to be selected to attend the event and represent New Zealand.

Player selection for each grade will be determined as at the 1st June 2017. Squash New Zealand will select the following number of players (from applications received) for representation at the 2017 Oceania Closed Championships:

1x A Grade	1x A Grade
2x B Grade	2x B Grade
2x C Grade	2x C Grade

As this is the first occasion that NZ will be represented at the event the panel will take into account the relative strengths of other nations and field a team accordingly.

Selectors will take into consideration the following:

- Grading List Activity
- Significant previous performances
- Regular competition in District or National events

- Women 3 players
